1. National Horticulture Mission

Agriculture is the main occupation of more than 60 percent of the people in Jharkhand. ADWAA, during 2013-14, took up a project to promote the holistic development of horticulture sector in the area with the help of National Horticulture Mission. 2. Agriculture Development

a. Awareness and Training on SRI Technique of Paddy crop:

In order to increase the yield of rice, farmers in the selected blocks of Dumka district were given training on system of Rice intensification. A three day workshop was organized and 100 farmers were covered under this programme.

The SRI training was rendered with full support from beneficiaries as well as the allies.



b. Demonstration of cereals (Pigion pea/Arhar , Urad , Mung) , Pea , Gram in Dumka and Ramgarh Block of Dumka District and Hiranpur Block in Pakur District

During the year 2013-2014, a demonstration program was organized in the Ramgarh and Dumka district of Jharkhand.

c. Adoption of Organic farming

We do understand the importance of conserving the biodiversity. Over the past few years, excessive use of fertilizers has created havoc upon the ecology and food security.

In order to mitigate all such risks, we at ADWAA, keep organizing awareness as well as capacity building campaigns where farmers belonging to marginalized categories are provided training on organic farming. In all, 35 villages in 10 panchayats were covered.

5. Environment Awareness

During the year 2013-14, three awareness campaigns for environment conservations were held in the Dumka and Pakur district. Awareness campaigns were organized at the community level. Due to deforestation, the environment degradation in the two districts has increased. The campaigns spread awareness on tree plantation and its significance, waste management, safe disposal of garbage etc.

The programs were organized with the full support of Ministry of Environment and Forest and were rendered with an overwhelming response from the community as well as other supporters.



6. Pulse Polio Awareness Campaign

As a part of wider health campaign, 3 pulse polio awareness campaigns were organized in Dumka. 312 members of the community actively participated in them.

Similarly, 2 campaigns were organized in Pakur, where an incidence of polio among children is quite. In all, 118 people extended their full support with their active participation.

7. Awareness Campaigns on NREGA

A workshop on project NREGA (National Rural Employment Guarantee Act) was organized backed by Ministry of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj. The programme was conducted to aware the rural youth of Dumka and Pakur. The programme apart from awareness generation also included interpersonal communication between the beneficiaries.
